

Prior to Using the Swing: Read and Follow these Safety Instructions

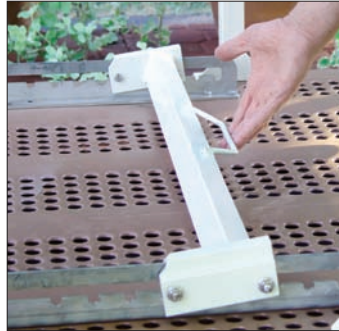

How to use the Wheelchair Accessible WhisperGLIDE Swing



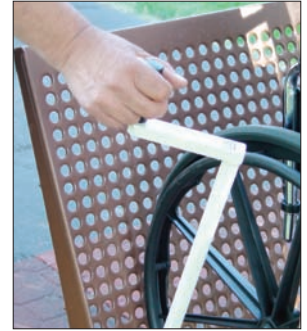
1. Secure both swing lock-ups in ground receptacle.
(See Red Arrow.)



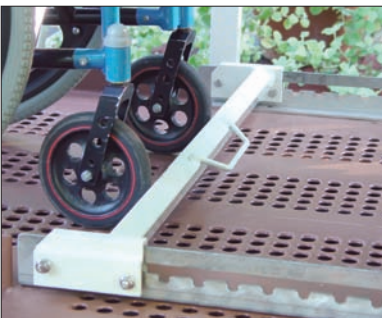
2. Adjust the stop bar to allow adequate space, for a nonstandard wheelchair.



3. Lower Ramp **completely** before pushing wheelchair onto ramp and then platform.



4. Raise ramp to upright position with the gearbox crank.



5. If necessary, re-adjust the stop bar to secure front wheels. Lock the wheelchair brakes.



6. Release both swing lockups. Swing gently. Before exiting, secure both lockups. Then, lower ramp **completely** before wheeling wheelchair back down the ramp. Return ramp to upright position.

- **Electronic Wheelchairs** also require assistance while entering and exiting.

- **Use Only** with supervision of an individual trained in swing use.

- **Do Not** enter or exit swing while it is moving.

- **Always** stay sitting upright when the swing is in motion. Do Not lean sideways past vertical hangers or arm rests. Do Not allow children to stand on swing seats.

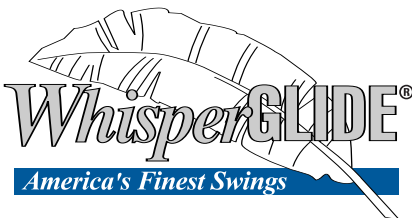
- **Always** keep hands, head and feet inside seat area.

- **To Create Swing Movement**, use wheelchair-side therapeutic handles; occupants of bench seat may use hands on table push-pull bar, or use their feet on the platform.

- **Weight Limits:** Total weight of all of the swing occupants is 900 pounds. Limit total weight of the wheelchair and the occupant of the wheelchair to 450 pounds.

- **To Prevent Mis-Use:** If needed, Padlock the swing when proper adult supervision is not available.
